GENERAL INFORMATION

ARRIVAL

- The sailing club postcode is PO11 9SL
- A member of security staff will grant access at the barrier, if no one is there press the buzzer.
- At the dinghy park entrance one of the volunteers will direct you to unload your boat and take it to the correct berth.
- Important please be prepared to unload quickly to avoid any delays
- Any additional trailers or double stackers need to be moved to the overflow car park and not the causeway.

PARKING

- Parking is on the causeway and in the overflow car park at the end of the causeway near the RNLI station
- The barrier code will be sent to you in the days leading up to the event
- If possible we recommend leaving your vehicles at your accommodation for the week.
- Overflow car park is locked overnight between 22:00 and 08:00
- When parking on the cause way park DO NOT parallel park, please park at an angle to allow maximum capacity.
- Please do not block the causeway it needs to be clear for emergency vehicle access

REGISTRATION

- All competitors are required to register upon arrival. Registration will be at in the training room from 14:30 -17:00 on Saturday and 08:30-10:00 on Sunday.
- Trolley tags will be handed out which must be attached to the bow of your launch trolley.
- Dinghies will be berthed in buddy groups. Berthing plan will be available on a nearby notice board, berth numbers will be marked on a post in the dinghy park
- A wristband will be issued which needs to be worn during the week to identify you as a competitor

CLUB ACCESS

- Changing Rooms and toilets will be open from 08:00 to 18:00

BAR AND CATERING

- Breakfast will be available every day from 08.00-10.00 (or later if demand is there)
- The beach bar will be open for snacks after sailing until 17:00
- Evening meals will be served as per the timetable above
- Please book meals in advance; there will be a **limited number** of tickets available to purchase at registration and afterwards from reception, with a deadline of 17:00 on the day before the meal is due to be served.

DEPARTURE

- All equipment should be removed from the club site within 24hours of the end of the event.
- The overflow car park will be closed at 22:00 on the 25th August and will not be re-opened the following day, so please remove all vehicles and equipment.
