DIRECTIONS AND ARRIVAL

Proceed down A30 towards Penzance. At Long Rock, Newtown Roundabout, take 2nd turning, sign posted St. Michaels Mount and Marazion and follow the signs.

Proceed along Newtown Rd to the end, turn left to Marazion.

On entering the town, (West End Rd) there is a large car park on your right-hand side. (seaward side).

Turn right into this car park (opposite Godolphin Drive) what3words ///eaten.modem.melts.

Proceed into car park and turn immediately left before the Beach Box café. In front you will see our meet and greet team at the entrance to the Folly Field dinghy park marked by flags. what3words ///costumes.clattered.hacking

Unhitch your boat and take it to your allotted space.

If you have a double stacking trolley our team will direct you to an area where these can be kept.

CAR PARKING

After leaving your boat, you will need to find a car park space in the car park and pay to park. (This parking is camera operated registration number recognition and there is a substantial fine for avoidance.) The car park is operated by JustPark, location number 528051. If you download the app you will be able to get a weekly ticket 7-day pass at £55.00. The car park gets very busy, however there is an overflow car park over the road which the club understand can be used using the same ticket. DO NOT use either of the car parks closer to the Sailing Club as these are short stay only.

Camper vans must park in the overflow car park.

Please be aware there is NO overnight sleeping in the car park, this is monitored and strictly enforced.

CLUBHOUSE

Once you have put you boat in the dinghy park you can walk to the town and **MBSC Clubhouse**, which can be found in the lane just before The Godolphin Hotel, Bar and Restaurant.

REGISTRATION

All competitors are required to register. Registration will be in the MBSC Clubhouse on Sunday from 9.30am-6pm and on Monday from 9-10am.

CATERING

Breakfast rolls, hot drinks and snacks will be available every day from 9am – 10.30am.

Evening meals, for those who have pre-ordered, will be served as per the timetable above.
